

Terms and Conditions Youth Creation

1. Enrolment

By enrolling in classes at Youth Creation, students and/or parents/guardians agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions.

All registration information must be accurate and kept up to date. Parents/guardians are responsible for informing the school of any changes to contact details, medical information, or emergency contacts.

2. Fees and Payments

- Fees are payable in advance and must be paid by the due date stated on the invoice.
- Payments may be made via the cardless payment link or cash. Starting September 2026.
- Late payments may result in a student being unable to attend classes until outstanding fees have been settled.
- All fees are non-refundable except where required by law or at the discretion of management.
- The value is inclusive of the full calendar month, covering all scheduled YC classes and private lessons regardless of planned or unplanned absence.

3. Attendance

- Students are expected to attend classes regularly and punctually.
- Missed classes are non-refundable and cannot be transferred unless agreed by management.
- If a student is unable to attend due to illness or other circumstances, parents/guardians should notify the school as soon as possible.

4. Cancellation and Withdrawal

- A minimum of 4 week's written notice is required to withdraw from classes.
- Fees remain payable during the notice period.
- The school reserves the right to cancel or reschedule classes where necessary. In such cases, an alternative class, credit, or refund may be offered.

5. Behaviour and Conduct

- Students are expected to behave respectfully towards teachers, staff, fellow students, and visitors.
- Bullying, abusive language, discrimination, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.

- The school reserves the right to suspend or remove any student whose behaviour is deemed unacceptable. Fees will not normally be refunded in these circumstances.

6. Health and Safety

- Parents/guardians must disclose any relevant medical conditions, allergies, injuries, or additional support/behavioural needs.
- Students should not attend classes when suffering from a contagious illness.
- The school may administer basic first aid where appropriate and seek emergency medical assistance if required.

7. Uniform and Dress Code

- Students must attend classes in suitable appropriate clothing and footwear for the class.
- Jewellery should be kept to a minimum for safety reasons.
- Long hair should be tied back where required.

8. Photography and Video Recording

- The school may take photographs and video recordings during classes, performances, workshops, and events for educational, promotional, and marketing purposes, including social media platforms.

- Consent will be obtained separately where required.
- Parents/guardians may withdraw consent in writing at any time.

9. Performances and Events

- Students may be invited to participate in performances, examinations, competitions, workshops, and other events.
- Additional fees, costumes, travel expenses, or rehearsal commitments may apply.
- Participation in these activities may be subject to attendance, commitment, and teacher recommendation.

10. Competition Team Requirements

Students selected for a YC Competition Teams are expected to demonstrate commitment, dedication, and regular attendance.

- Competition Team members must attend all required team classes each week.
- Competition Team members are required to attend the designated Sunday Street Dance class as part of their training programme.
- Selection for competitions is by invitation only. Participation in competitions is at the sole discretion of Team YC, and invitations may be offered based on

attendance, commitment, attitude, progress, and team suitability.

- Team YC reserves the right to review a student's place on the Competition Team if attendance or commitment requirements are not met.

11. Personal Property

- Students are responsible for their personal belongings.
- The school accepts no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage to personal property brought onto the premises.

12. Limitation of Liability

- Participation in dance, acting, singing, and other performing arts activities involves a degree of physical activity and inherent risk.
- While reasonable care will be taken at all times, Youth Creation accepts no liability for injury, loss, or damage except where caused by negligence or where liability cannot legally be excluded.

13. Safeguarding

- The welfare of children and adults is of paramount importance.
- The school operates in accordance with its safeguarding and child protection policies.

- Any safeguarding concerns will be handled in line with statutory guidance and procedures.

14. Data Protection

- Personal information will be collected, stored, and processed in accordance with applicable data protection legislation.
- Information will only be used for legitimate school purposes and will not be shared with third parties except where required by law or with consent.

15. Changes to Terms and Conditions

The school reserves the right to amend these Terms and Conditions at any time. Updated versions will be made available to students and parents/guardians.
